  - ii) An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC notification dated 18.07.2018.
  - iii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

(OR)

(B) An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

# **Essential Qualifications (Sl.No. 10)**

- I. Master's Degree in any discipline with not less than 50% of marks.

- I. A Masters Degree in any discipline and M.Ed., each with a minimum of 55% Marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.
- II. Ph.D. degree
- III. Professor/Associate Professor with a total service/ experience of at least fifteen years of teaching/research in Universities, Colleges and other institutions of higher education.
- IV. A minimum of 10 research publications in peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals.
- V. A minimum of 110 Research Score as per Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC notification dated 18.07.2018.

#### **Tenure**

- I. A College Principal shall be appointed for a period of five years, extendable for another term of five years on the basis of performance assessment by a Committee appointed by the University, constituted as per these regulations.
- II. After the completion of his/her term as Principal, the incumbent shall join back his/her parent organization with the designation as Professor and in the grade of the Professor.

### Instructions to candidates

- 1. Candidates should send **three copies** of their filled-in applications {Part I and Part II *(Details of Academic Record)*} in the prescribed format along with a soft copy in a CD. Otherwise the application will not be entertained.
- 2. Separate applications are to be submitted for each post along with fee prescribed.

- 8. Minimum eligibility does not vest any right on the candidate to be called for interview.
